Festa Al Fresco At Greenwich Historical Society

Cos Cob, CT, May 19, 2014--The Greenwich Historical Society will host its second annual Festa Al Fresco, a potluck supper to celebrate the history and the community of Italian immigrants who settled in Greenwich in the early twentieth century. The family “festa” was launched last year as part of the Historical Society’s programming for the exhibition *From Italy to America* and in celebration of the Town of Greenwich’s twinning (or *gemallagio*) with the Italian cities of Rose and Morra di Sanctis, where many of Greenwich’s Italian early immigrants hailed from. The event proved so successful that it’s back by popular demand on June 29. Guests are invited to demonstrate their culinary skills and to show off favorite family recipes (enough to share with 6-8) in one of four categories: antipasti/appetizers, pasta/main dishes, sides and salads, or desserts. Wine, musical entertainment and crafts for kids are included in the price of admission. *Mangiamo!*
