# Letter from Board Co-Chairs and Executive Director



Dear Friends,

We are pleased to present this report on Greenwich Historical Society's activities from July 2022 through June 2023, our most recently completed fiscal year, featuring highlights of our education programs, exhibitions, research and community impact. We are indebted to our board and professional staff who dedicate themselves to advancing our mission to preserve and interpret Greenwich history to strengthen the community's connection to our past, to each other and to our future.

In September we presented Chuck Royce with the prestigious David Ogilvy Preservation Award, followed by a fireside chat with Chuck and Deborah Royce moderated by Cynthia Blumenthal, which highlighted their impactful preservation projects.

The Historical Society's yearlong celebration of its 90th anniversary culminated in October in a grand dinner dance at Easterly, home of Susan Bevan and the site of one of Greenwich's last remaining Great Estates. The funds from this event supported the Historical Society's stewardship of Bush-Holley House, exhibitions and work with schools and community groups.

This past year also brought a long-awaited exhibition, *Life and Art: The Greenwich Paintings of John Henry Twachtman*, masterfully curated by scholar and author Lisa N. Peters. Our thanks once again to John Nelson for opening his home to our members and for his continued work to preserve and interpret its legacy as the inspiration for Twachtman's art.

In March our exhibition *Sports! More Than Just a Game* opened with a wide array of public programs, and it inspired the decision of the board to honor 10 extraordinary scholastic and club coaches and to select Olympic gold-medalist and NBA All-Star Allan Houston as this year's History in the Making honoree in recognition of his philanthropic contributions in Greenwich and beyond. We express our sincere gratitude for the work and enthusiasm of our Steering Committee Co-Chairs, Cynthia Chang, Tom Clephane and Chuck Niemeth.

Our inaugural Spring Tour debuted in May and June, chaired by Lauren duPont, Susannah Heyworth and Catherine Tompkins. Lisa and Chris Errico hosted a Patron Party with honorary chair Aerin Lauder. We visited four outstanding gardens and homes, thanks to our hosts Anne Harrison, Alease Fisher Tallman, Ramsey Frank and Shauna Varvel.

# Meeting Our Strategic Goals



## Broader Audience

We broadened our audience through meaningful engagement with the community through the *Sports! More Than Just a Game* exhibition and related programs, attracting collectors and families from many walks of life, near and far. Music on the Great Lawn summer concerts, Tavern Garden Markets and Morning Market Talks attracted new and returning members through free admission and other incentives.



## Fuller History

We told a fuller history of the town and its increasingly diverse population. Our third season of the Shining a Light virtual lecture series continued to amplify underrepresented voices on topics ranging from LGBTQ to Indigenous and South-Asian American communities. Our community partnership with India Culture Center, in support of the state's mandated K-12 Asian American/Pacific Islander curriculum, culminated in the student-curated exhibit "My Story, Our Future" that explored South-Asian Connecticut youth identity through personal family stories and artifacts. Our Witness Stones program continued to share the stories and honor the humanity and contributions of the individuals enslaved by the Bush family.



## Organizational Excellence

We deepened our commitment to organizational excellence through quality communications, programs and services that welcomed and engaged adults and families, school groups, researchers and visitors to our campus at the Museum Store and Cafe, Library and Archives, Bush-Holley House and Vanderbilt Education Center.

We preserve and interpret Greenwich history to strengthen the community's connection to our past, to each other and to our future.

As a result of our work, our community will have a stronger sense of place, gain a fuller appreciation of our shared past and be better equipped to embrace opportunities to build a more informed and just society.

In service of this mission and vision, the Historical Society is framing its work from 2022 through 2026 under the theme of telling a fuller history of Greenwich to a broader audience, with a focus on including, engaging and representing the town's many communities.

## Preservation & Stewardship

We worked collaboratively to build public awareness of historic assets in town and in our collections, and to advocate for their preservation, garnering a major Good-to-Great Grant to fund critical environmental upgrades for the National Historic Landmark Bush-Holley House. Co-administered by the Connecticut Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD) and CT Humanities, the grant will support a comprehensive series of upgrades to the Bush-Holley House's climate control systems, ensuring the continued stewardship of its historic furnishings and original artworks, and bringing the visitor experience to a modern standard of comfort.



## Growth & Sustainability

We achieved revenue growth in alignment with operating expenses through a year of successful fundraising events including our 90th Anniversary, inaugural Spring Tour and the Greenwich Historic Trust. Along with consistent effort and return on new and renewed memberships, we realized a 40% increase in attendance at programs, exhibitions, tours and school programs, with a total of over 18,000 participants.

## Gifts to the Archives and the Museum Collections

July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023

To preserve our past for future generations, the Greenwich Historical Society Archives depends on the assistance of people interested in preserving the unique culture of Greenwich. We acquire, preserve and make available to the public original documents and publications about important aspects of the history of the Town of Greenwich from its founding to the present. These can include original letters, diaries, scrapbooks, minutes, reports and publications such as books, magazines, menus, brochures, flyers and campaign literature. The Museum Collection is comprised of objects that document the material culture of present and former inhabitants of Greenwich and its region. Particular emphasis is given to items connected to the history of the Bush-Holley Historic Site or those useful to its interpretation. Objects include, but are not limited to, items associated with Greenwich people, places or events; fine and decorative arts; and maritime, agricultural, industrial and domestic artifacts that reflect the activities of the Bush family during the New Nation and of members of the Cos Cob colony of American Impressionism. On behalf of current and future students, researchers and scholars, we would like to express our sincere appreciation to all who have contributed to these collections.



# IMLS Grant Recap

Dozens of archival collections and thousands of historic photographs became searchable and accessible to the Greenwich community thanks to the completion in June of a three-year Museums for America grant from the Institute of Museums and Library Services (IMLS). The grant funding allowed for the addition of two full-time staff positions to fully arrange and describe a backlog of important collection material that had been donated to the archives over many years.



The extensive Greenwich photograph collection and related real estate images were fully digitized, and

descriptive catalog entries were created to allow researchers to quickly find items of interest.

“Educational and exhibition-related programs have already been enhanced by items discovered during the grant work,” says Curator of

Archives Christopher Shields. “Information in the ledger collection, for example, has provided new insight into the economic lives of enslaved and formerly enslaved people who lived in town. And revelations into the life of a working-class couple in the early 20th century are offered by a newly-processed family collection.”

Staff involved over the course of the project are Project Archivists Leslie Albamonte and Ashley Aberg and Digital Associates Kelsie Dalton and Dean McKenna.

# 2022–2023 Treasurer's Report

Heinz Maeusli, Treasurer

The following provides an overview of the fiscal year that ended June 30, 2023. At the time of this publication, the audit was not finalized. However, we don't expect any significant adjustments. Once the audit is completed, we will make financial statements and Form 990 available on our website and in hard copy at the Greenwich Historical Society.

We had another successful year with several major events. We celebrated our 90th Anniversary at Easterly, a classic Greenwich shorefront estate. The dinner dance evoked the glamorous Café Society era and legendary El Morocco nightclub and featured the esteemed author, Doris Kearns Goodwin. We also hosted a Spring Tour, a sold-out event, that raised funds to support educational programs and resources accessible to all students and teachers in Greenwich.

Another highlight was the long-awaited exhibition *Life and Art: The Greenwich Paintings of John Henry Twachtman*. The exhibition was met with much enthusiasm and praise. Ancillary activities such as the Museum Store, the facility rental business, and our concerts continue to perform better than we had anticipated. Our *Discover Greenwich* program keeps growing, and it promotes community engagement and a sense of belonging while enriching our knowledge of Greenwich history.

We realized an operating profit of \$364K in FY 2023. Total revenues and assets released from restrictions for operating purposes amounted to \$2.72 million, almost exactly the same as in the prior year. Total functional expenses were \$2.35 million, an increase of \$259K compared to FY 2022, largely driven by inflation. The Historical Society ended FY 2023 with total net assets of \$24.09 million. We are looking forward to this coming year and will give our best to grow revenues and to strengthen the financial situation of the Historical Society.



# IN MEMORIAM

## David O. Brownwood



David was a wise, thoughtful and beloved trustee for 18 years and a loyal supporter of the Historical Society both financially and through his nine years of service as an officer and on the executive, finance and building and grounds

committees. Many of us have been inspired by his well-timed words of encouragement and optimistic spirit. In addition to a distinguished career as Senior Counsel (and partner 1973-2003) at Cravath, Swaine & Moore, his service to the community included board member of the Friends of Nathaniel Witherell, former President of the Greenwich Library Board and former Chairman of the Greenwich Country Day School Board. His love of history was evident through his attendance at the Historical Society's exhibitions and public programs, and also by his former service on the boards of the Royal Oak Foundation and the Benjamin Franklin House Foundation.

## Peter Crumbine



Husband of Greenwich Historical Society Trustee Bea Crumbine, Peter served on Greenwich's Board of Estimate and Taxation. In 1999, further politics beckoned, which led to five elections as Selectman for the Town of Greenwich and service

under the administrations of Lolly Prince, Dick Bergstresser, Jim Lash and Peter Tesei. He also earned great success in United States Masters Swimming, where he both swam competitively on a local and national level and chaired the Masters Swimming Long Distance Committee. He also founded the Greenwich Swim Committee. Peter's devotion to the weekly Horseneck Club gatherings was little short of legendary.

## Suzanne Frank



Suzanne's work with and support of charitable organizations in her communities was a passion that extended throughout her life. She was a loyal and strong supporter of the Greenwich Historical Society and served on the Board of Trustees for

18 years. She served as co-chair of the Society's Development Committee, was one of the leaders in the Society's campaign to ReImagine the Campus and made possible the addition of the Frank Family Foundation Gallery. She also had significant involvement with the Greenwich YWCA, American Red Cross, Red Ribbon Foundation, Greenwich Riding & Trails, and Boys and Girls Club of Greenwich. She was a proud recipient of the YWCA: 2012 Spirit of Greenwich Award. She showed compassion for many and was known for her spontaneous acts of kindness.

## Nola Taylor





Vanderbilt Society members are invited to special private and exclusive events each year. This spring, members enjoyed a special luncheon at the Riverside Yacht Club, as well as an illustrated presentation and book signing by author William R. Cross on the life and works of Winslow Homer, including a series of watercolors painted in Greenwich during the spring of 1880, one of which was titled "Field Point, Greenwich, Conn." and exhibited by Homer in January of 1881.

"As a Trustee of the Greenwich Historical Society for over 25 years, I have witnessed its transformation into a vibrant community organization, particularly as a result of the ReImagine the Campus Campaign, which realized additional space to accommodate many more programs and services.
