We receive many research requests and have limited staffing. Please allow up to 3 weeks for a response.

The research fee supports the staff time dedicated to determining what (if any) information relevant to your question(s) can be found in the Historical Society's collections and then compiling and sharing this information with you. We will work to find useful information, however there are times when it will not be available in our collection material.

Please note that the research fee is non-refundable. The fee supports the best effort by staff to determine if an answer to your question(s) can be found in our collections. It does not guarantee that you will receive the requested information.
